

## NEW 3SquaresVT program for Vermonters 60 or older or Disabled.

3SquaresVT in a SNAP offers Vermonters 60 or older and/or disabled an easier way to receive and keep 3SquaresVT food benefits.

This program is for households where everyone is:
\*at least 60 years old or receiving disability benefits, and
\*not earning income from a job or self-employment.

#### Households that qualify will be able to:


- apply using a simpler, shorter application, and
- keep their benefit for three years without needing to do an annual review.

3Squares in a SNAP is a demonstration project authorized by the Federal Nutrition Service of the USDA. The goal is to increase the participation of older and disabled Vermonters in the state's federal nutrition assistance program: 3SquaresVT. Vermont's Everybody Eats program that addresses food insecurity by providing a weekly meal to residents through the state, has been extended until April 1, 2022.

A person is eligible if they are:
60 years if age or older
Handicapped or disabled and living in a housing facility where a meal program is operated
Non-Senior volunteer performing essential duties for the operations of the meal program
OR the Spouse of an eligible recipient regardless of age.




